May 14, 2020 Minutes

Meeting called to order by President Jim McCormack at 5:15

Meis motion passed

March 12 minutes read and approved

Treasurer's report: \$27,613 in checking, \$11,876 in Range improvement acct.

Income for March – April 2020 \$2284

Income for March – April 2019 \$9100

Doug's report: During the shutdown, lots of maintenance, grading, and frame repair accomplished on Bay 2. Bay 1 needs the same treatment.

Special events: Kathy Love and SST CCW classes scheduled for July 11-12 and May 30. Cooper has cancelled all events for 2020. Teller Youth shoot will have to move to the 300yd range to accommodate personal spacing.

We will ask Tammany if she feels safe in coming to work on June 3.

John Marshall has dimensions of roof for repairs and will order beams from Triad next week.

Dave and John got the 200yd cover gutters fixed.

John reported on fixing drainage on the 200 yd range: He proposed removing asphalt that is in front of the firing line, installing a drain tile and replacing asphalt with proper slope.

### New Business

We will start posting board meeting minutes on the website

Doug suggested three items:

1. Issuing cards to day use shooters who have watched the safety video to expedite check-in for repeat shooters.
2. A \$1 per day maintenance fee for all members.
3. Initiating a bar code reader system to expedite check in for members which will also create a tracking record for member usage. Estimated cost would be \$1200.
  - a. We have discussed a bar code reader before and agreed to the idea but no timeline for implementation was decided. Lee Riffel has been in contact with Member Ties, our membership tracking software, and reports that the system is able to handle bar code input.

Jim Dennis offered to pay for the bar code reader and printer. Thank you Jim!

Dave H. moved to get a bar code reader system on line by the end of July. Mike W. second. Motion passed. Doug, Lee Riffel and Dan will make a committee to get it going.

Dave H. moved to implement a \$1 per day, per shooter for members to start on September 1. Mike W. seconded. This has been brought up before. A long discussion ensued with many points mentioned. Motion passed.

The consensus of support for the fee was to generate money for more significant, long term maintenance and repair. As a group, the board dislikes raising fees. However, the range keeps getting older and bigger and more people are using it. The current fee schedule barely covers day to day maintenance and very little in the way of larger repairs.
